ENTER THE CONTEST! Submission Deadline: September 20, 2022

Trucking Moves America Forward (TMAF) is seeking young artists in middle school to join their art competition. Students are asked to create a design for a big rig trailer wrap that depicts the theme, “What does trucking bring you?” TMAF trailer wraps cover 18 wheelers and travel America’s highways. Trailer wraps are a great opportunity to educate motorists about the value of the trucking industry – and a great way to display the work of emerging young artists. Designs may include images of everyday items that trucks bring a child or his or her family and community. If you would like to enter a student, grades 6-8, please review the following rules and enter below.

CATEGORIES

- 1. Hand-Drawn Art:** Crayon, colored pencil, marker, paint, etc.
- 2. Digital Art:** Graphic design, digital drawing, etc.
- 3. Craft:** Handmade items such as a collage, diorama, etc.

WINNER RECOGNITION

TMAF will announce 13 total winners in the winter 2022. There will be four (4) winners in each of the three (3) categories: Gold, Silver, Bronze and Honorable Mention, and there will be (1) one grand prize winner

Winners will receive:

- Grand prize-winning design to be printed as a trailer wrap for an 18-wheeler that will travel America’s highways!
- Inclusion in a winner announcement video
- Recognition on TMAF’s blog, social media channels
- Recognition in a press release that will be distributed to local media in each winner’s market
- A framed copy of the winning work
- An award certificate
- Inclusion in a future art contest calendar (pending)

RULES FOR ALL CONTEST ENTRIES

Entry deadline is September 20, 2022.

- Artwork must include imagery or references to large trucks and what trucks deliver and how it is meaningful in one’s life. Artwork should not depict crashes and injuries; messages should be kept positive.
- Each student can submit up to three (3) entries.
- A parent or guardian must complete and sign the entry form. Submissions must be horizontal (landscape) in layout or orientation; vertical layouts will not be accepted.
- The student must produce the artwork without assistance from anyone else. The entry must be original. It cannot be a copy or modification of another work, such as a picture that is copied and then colored.
- Submissions must not include any copyrighted logos and brands.
- Software or online programs may be used to assemble/edit an entry; however, the entry must be primarily generated by the student’s own creativity and concept.

HOW TO SUBMIT

- 1.** Email submissions to marketing@truckingmovesamerica.com. Subject line must read: “2022 TMAF Art Contest Submission: [Student’s First and Last Name].”
- 2.** All entries must be submitted as a high-resolution photo or scan. Accepted file types include JPG, PNG, or PDF and must not exceed 10MB.
- 3.** The grand prize-winning entry will be required to submit the original art so it can be produced for the size of a trailer.
- 4.** The completed and signed entry form must be attached to the email. Digital signatures are acceptable, or the parent/guardian may print, sign, scan and email the form.
